### Literacy

During this half term, we will be sharing different stories featuring Percy the Park Keeper. This will help us to understand that all families are different.

### Maths

In our maths, we will be focusing on colour. We will be recognising different colours and finding items that are the same colour. We are then going to explore what happens when mixing two colours together. We will also be sorting different items according to colour and size.

## Understanding the World

We will be sharing our experiences with our new friends talking about events that have happened to us in the past.

We will also be creating bird feeders, observing the changes that happen to the ingredients as we make them.

#### WHY?
