English

In English, we will be reading *Last Stop on Market Street* and *Elmer and the Lost Teddy*. Whilst exploring these narrative texts, we will work on our comprehension skills, our drama skills and we will use these stories to write our own pieces of work. We will focus on retelling a character's routine and writing a recount.

Maths

In maths this half term, our topic is place value. We will be working with numbers up to 10 and making sure that we know how to write these numbers correctly. We will be counting, ordering and comparing these numbers and placing them on a number line. We will also be looking at 1 more and 1 less and the inverse operation.

Science

In Science this half term, our topic is *Animals Including Humans*. We will be focussing on humans and exploring the five senses.



How was school different in the past?



WHY?

Children will gain an understanding of what schools used to be like, from this they will make comparisons with what modern schools are like. Giving them an understanding of how times have changed and progressed through time.

WOW:

A day in the life of a child from a school over 100 years ago.

OUTCOME:

To be able to compare schools from the past to now.

Computing

In computing this half term, we will be learning about computing systems and networks and will be exploring technology around us.

Religious Education

Our topic in RE this half term is 'What does it mean to belong to a faith community?'

We will not be covering geography objectives this half term.

History

In our historical study this half term, we will be looking at schools from the past. We will be comparing how schools were many years ago to what they are like now.

Art and Design

In Art and Design, our main focus is drawing and we will be exploring mark making.

Design Technology

Our Design and technology topic is structures. In this topic, we will be constructing a windmill.

Music

Our music topic this half term is 'under the sea'. We will be composing and performing a piece of music linked to the sea.
