English
In English, we will be looking at the fairy tale *Little Red Riding Hood* and we will be reading an alternative version of this well-known story. The children will be sequencing the story and then starting to write their own story based on *Little Red*. We will also be looking at shape poems and learning how to write our own.

Maths
In maths this half term, we will be looking at multiplying and dividing and how to calculate these equations. We will also be learning about money, time, directions and reinforcing our place value knowledge by extending our counting to 100.

Science
In Science this half term, we will continue to look at seasonal change and plants. We will apply our understanding of plants to practical tasks such as growing our own sunflowers. We will be working on our observation and investigation skills and trying to explain what we find out.
