## English

In English, we will be focusing on the story *The Iron Man*. We will be exploring the characters, themes, and events in the book to help us understand the story. As part of this topic, we will be writing our own short story inspired by *The Iron Man* and including a range of writing features such as speech, descriptive language, punctuation, and exciting vocabulary to make our writing more interesting and creative.

## Maths

In maths this half term, we will be finishing our topic on time before moving on to shape. We will be learning about the properties of different shapes and finding the perimeter of a variety of 2D shapes. Later in the term, we will begin statistics, where we will collect and interpret data, as well as create and read different types of graphs and charts.

## Science

In science this half term, we will be learning about magnets and forces. We will explore how magnets attract and repel each other and investigate which materials are magnetic. We will also learn about friction and how different surfaces can affect movement. As part of our investigations, we will be testing and comparing different metals and carrying out practical experiments to develop our scientific enquiry skills.



## Are all settlements the same?

We hope to gain a deeper understanding of the different types of settlements in the UK and how this is compared to New Delhi, India.

### WOW:

Trip - looking at our local area.

### OUTCOME:

To understand reasons for the location of human features. E.g. shops close to residential areas and transport links.
