Chantlers Primary School wins national awards for performance

Chantlers Primary School has been recognised nationally for its excellent results in 2017 based on data from the Department of Education and Ofsted, analysed by SSAT (the Schools, Students and Teachers network). Chantlers Primary School was found to be among the best performing primary schools in the country, and has enabled pupils' attainment at the 'expected and 'higher' standard at KS2 in Reading, Writing and Maths to be in the top 20% of all schools nationally, and has enabled pupils to make progress in Reading, Writing and Maths which is significantly higher than the national average at KS2, and is among the top 20% across all schools nationally.

The SSAT Educational Outcomes database compares all state-funded schools in England, with the highest performing for a range of key measures presented with SSAT Educational Outcomes Awards, sponsored by Lexonik. Chantlers Primary School will be presented with their awards during the summer term at a ceremony attended by winners from across the region.

"I am delighted that Chantlers Primary School has won Educational Outcomes Awards for Children's Attainment - top 20% and Children's Progress - top 20%.
